GENE HAAS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR MANUFACTURING EXCELLENCE

Fort Collins High School is announcing the establishment of a scholarship with a grant from the Gene Haas Foundation. The scholarships will be awarded to graduates of Fort Collins High School who plan to continue their education in the field of machining or manufacturing.

Terms of Scholarship:

- Five awards in the dollar amount of \$1100.00 to be awarded Fall 2023.
- Scholarship applies to tuition, fees, and books only.
- Scholarships are awarded to students with established financial need and outstanding academics.
- Deadline to apply is November 28, 2022.

Eligibility: The applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a graduating senior from Fort Collins High School in 2023
- Complete one or more career and technical education courses between grades 9 and 12
- Complete the scholarship application containing the following items:
 1. Completed and Signed Application Form
 2. Résumé with two references
 3. 200-word essay emphasizing how this scholarship would help in their success in a manufacturing and/or machining education
- If awarded a scholarship, complete a PSD Scholarship Recipient Form after being accepted to a machining/manufacturing program
