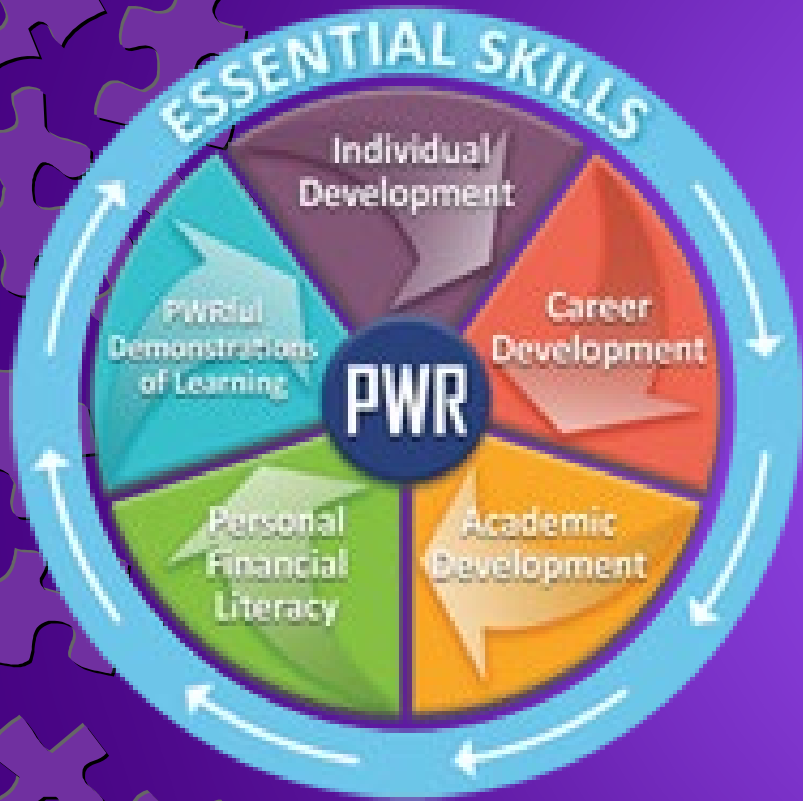

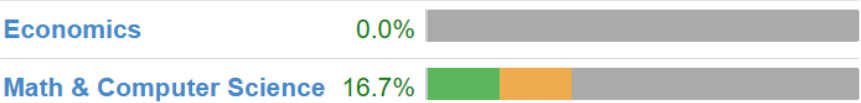

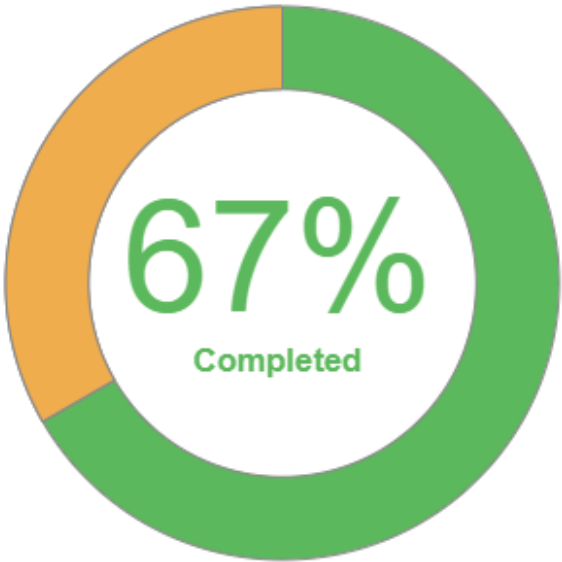

Grade 11 Language Arts

5863 | **US Literature and Composition (English 11):** 10 credits — grade 11 —English Language Arts — prerequisite: World Lit and Comp or College Prep World Lit and Comp

American Literature courses focus upon commonly known American authors and their work. Students improve their critical-thinking skills as they determine the underlying assumptions and values within the selected works and as they understand how the literature reflects the society of the time. Oral discussion is an integral part of this course as is the emphasis on narrative, informational/explanatory, and argumentative writing. At FCHS: **Writing and Language** along with **Reading** skills practice specific to the SAT are addressed in the spring semester.

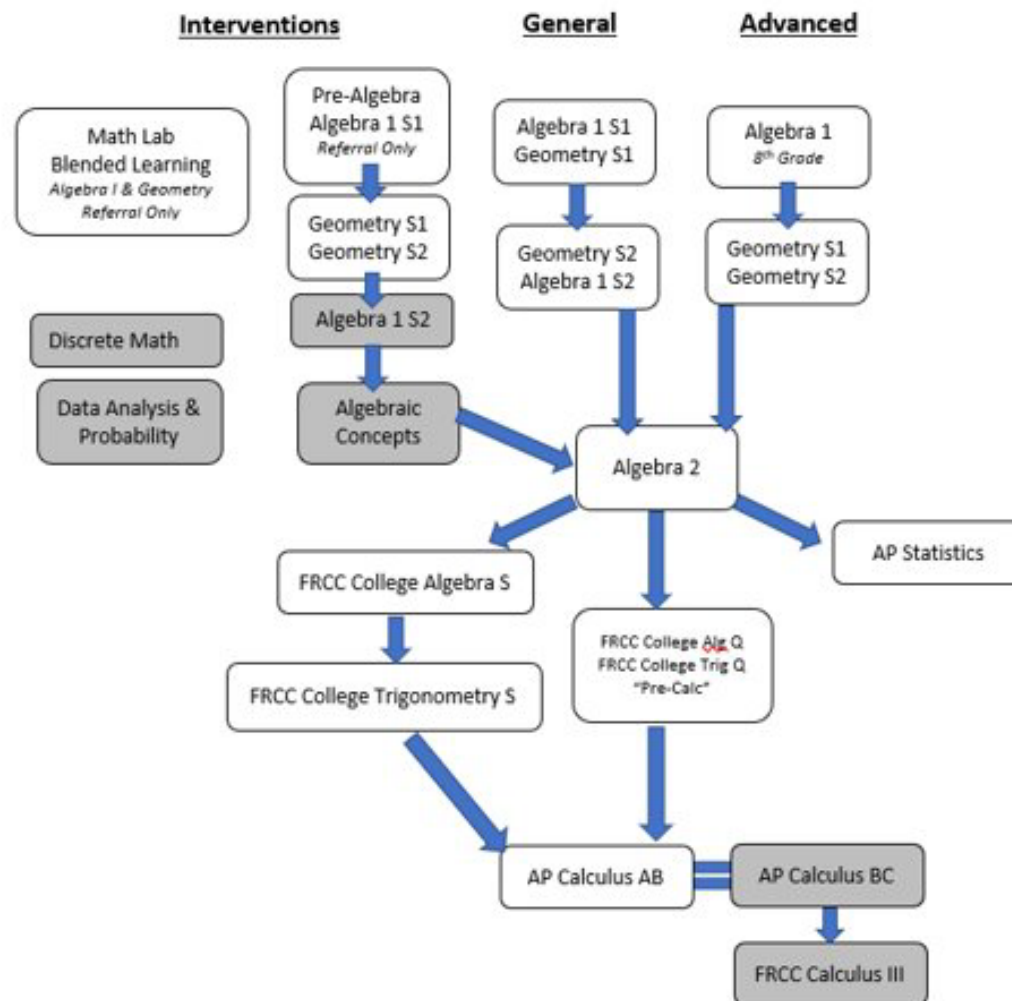
