

Attention Advanced Placement Students and their families:

The College Board released updated information regarding the status of this May's AP Exams on March 20 and there will be significant changes to the structure and administration of the exams. You are encouraged to access the following link for detailed information:

What follows is an overview of the main points:

- 1) There will be NO face-to-face exam administration. **Student will take a 45-minute online free-response exam at home**. There are no multiple-choice questions.
- 2) There will be 2 different testing dates to accommodate students who prefer to take the exam sooner or those who prefer more practice time. The exam schedule with both testing dates will be available by April 3.
- 3) For courses with digital portfolio submission requirements (Art and Seminar), the submission deadline has been extended to May 26 at 11:59 p.m. ET.
- 4) Included in the link is a table indicating which units of study per course will and will not be included for assessment. For each course, the tested content is limited to the first 75% of the course.
- 5) Online resources including review courses for teachers and students are available beginning on March 25. Additionally, specific free-response question types and relevant free-response questions in AP classroom will be unlocked for student use by April 3.
- 6) Students have the option of cancelling their exam(s) without being charged the \$40/exam late fee.
- 7) The payment deadline for the FCHS Advanced Placement Exams has been extended to Friday, May 1 at 4:30 pm.

Advanced Placement teachers are reaching out to students with assignments, learning opportunities, study resources and other information for specific AP courses. The information on the FCHS website will be updated regularly to reflect what becomes available from the College Board.
