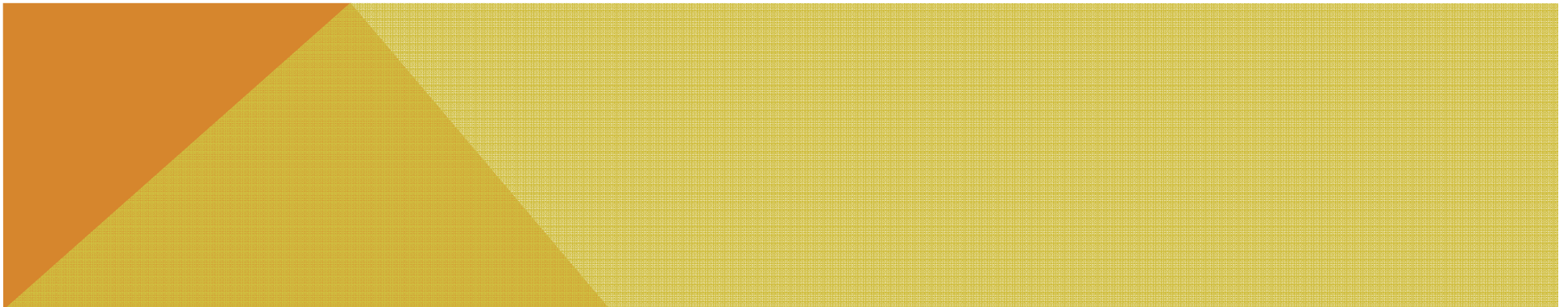

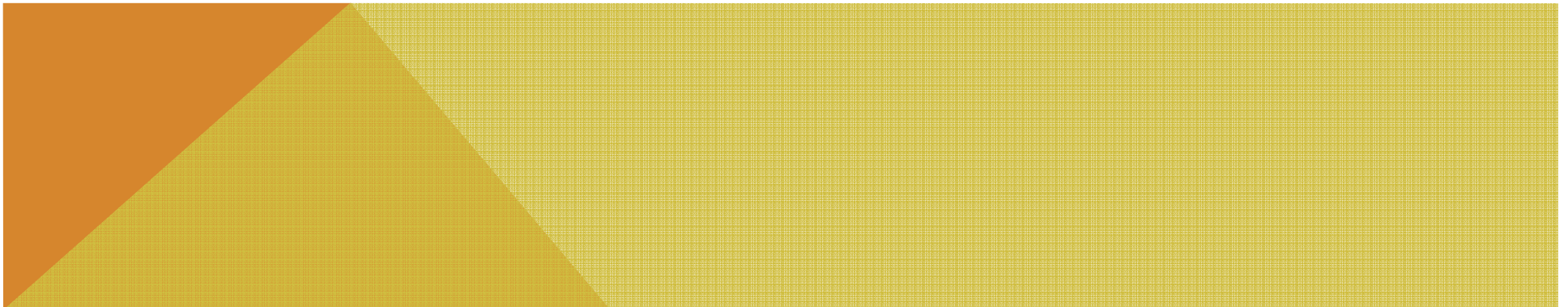


FAMILY CONNECTIONS

Then click on the ABOUT ME tab at the top of your screen.

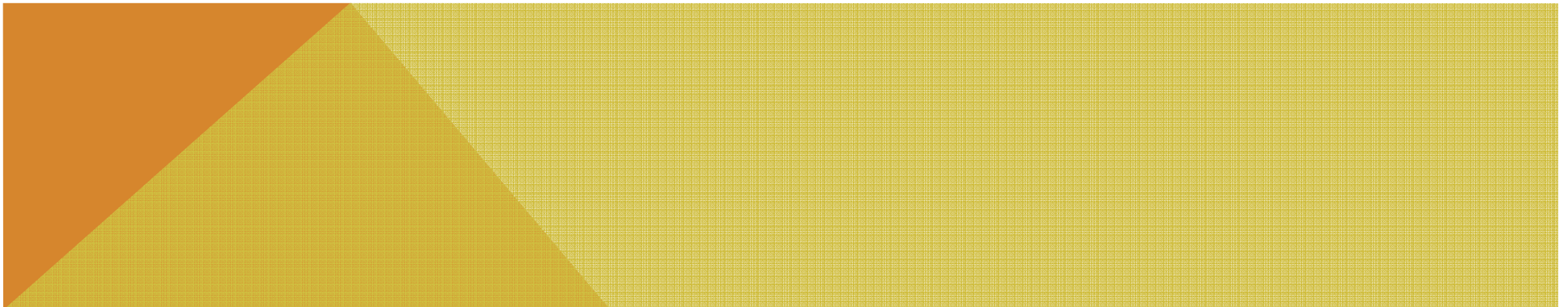

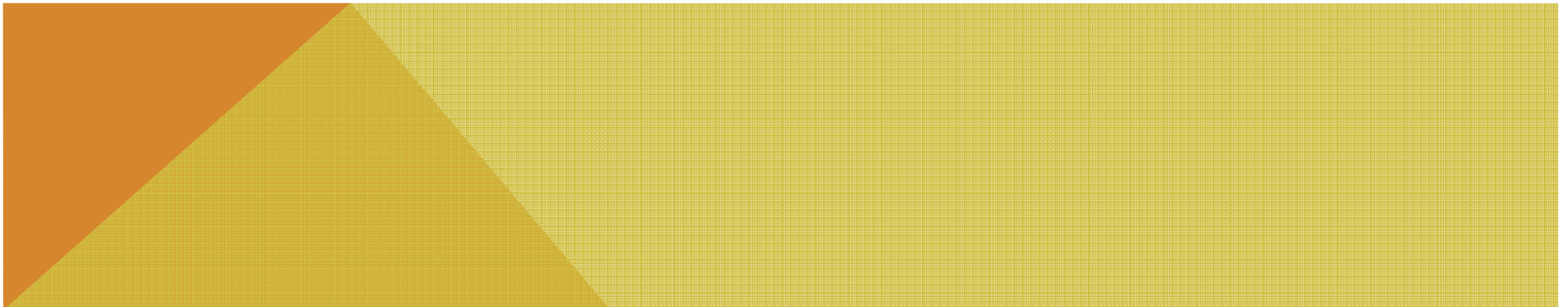


CHOOSING AN AREA OF FOCUS
