THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS IS LOCATED IN NORTHERN COLORADO IN THE FOOTHILLS OF THE ROCKY MOUNTAINS, AN HOUR NORTH OF DENVER. POPULATION OF APPROXIMATE 169,249 AND IS HOME TO COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY, FRONT RANGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE (LARIMAR CAMPUS) AND MANY HIGH-TECH INDUSTRIES. POU DRE SCHOOL DISTRICT INCLUDES THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS AND ADJACENT INCORPORATED AREAS.




